Things to know before arriving at the workshop:

- **Venue Location:** University of Alaska Fairbanks, Troth Yeddha' Campus, Butrovich Building, Board of Regents Meeting Room (2025 Yukon Drive). View the campus map [here](#).
- **Parking:** On-site parking is \$7/day. Participants can pay for parking at <https://www.passportparking.com/> or using the Passport Parking mobile app (Zone 908). Alternatively, parking day passes can be purchased from parking kiosk located next door at the University Museum (1962 Yukon Drive).
- **Attire:** The attire for the workshop event is business casual or OCP.
- **Start and End Times:** The workshop will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. each day and conclude by 5:00 p.m. Coffee and tea will be available at 8:00 a.m.
